All wood exposed to the elements expands and contracts on a daily basis due to the highs and lows of temperature and moisture changes. This is an ongoing cycle where moisture in liquid or gas form enters the wood and is then drawn out of the wood during dry weather. These effects can clearly be seen in the above

picture. These two samples of wood are Southern Yellow Pine and have both been exposed to full weather for 6 months. The top sample received no coating of any type whereas the bottom sample received a 2 x application of CUTEK Extreme in Clear. Simply put, CUTEK once applied to any wood species, greatly
